- II. Correspondence / Public Comment – Dr. Iwanicki noted that the public was invited to send any comments via e-mail, and that she had not received any.
- III. Approval/Minutes – Special Meeting 12/9/2020-- Ms. Petitti moved to approve the Minutes as presented by Dr. Budd this past December. Mr. Gallo seconded the motion and it was unanimously agreed to, with Ms. Squicciarro abstaining.
- IV. Report of New Business/Action Items
- A. Policy Code 9140, Teacher Representation on the Board of Education-- Dr. Iwanicki presented the policy as it is currently written and stated that it was requested by the Trumbull BOE to be reviewed in terms of best practice in the state of Connecticut. Recommendations, as relayed by senior staff at the Connecticut Association of Boards of Education (CABE,) were presented and all members were allowed to share their thoughts on the policy. Ms. Petitti made the motion to rescind policy 9140 from the Trumbull Board of Education Policies. Ms. Squicciarro seconded and it was agreed to be brought to the Board of Education for a First Reading on March 23, 2021.
- B. Policy Code 6172.6, Virtual Courses of Study-- Dr. Iwanicki presented the proposed revisions for the committee's review. After discussion with the committee and editing the language in one section, a motion was made by Ms. Squicciarro to adopt the revisions to Policy 6172.6. and Ms. Petitti seconded. The committee was unanimously in favor of bringing the policy to the Board of Education for a First Reading on March 23, 2021.

Ms. Petitti moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:45 p.m.; Ms. Squicciarro seconded. The motion was unanimously agreed to.
