If your child received a first dose at one of the clinics in November or another location, please make sure to wait the required three weeks before accessing the second dose. These clinics were purposely scheduled three weeks after our first-dose clinics. You may also take advantage of these clinics for a child’s first dose.

The BOE approved both the [2022-2023](#) and [2023-2024](#) district calendars at the November 16 Board of Education meeting.


Trumbull Police Department Tip Line
