

Dr. Jonathan S. Budd joined the Trumbull Public Schools community in July 2015 following two decades teaching English and directing writing and reading programs, including for fifteen years in the Region No. 9 (Easton-Redding) Public Schools. One of fewer than ten Connecticut educators with National Board Certification in English Language Arts / Adolescence and Young Adulthood, Dr. Budd holds a B.A. in English and Music from Connecticut College, an M.A. in English from Trinity College (Hartford), a Sixth-Year Diploma in Educational Leadership from the University of Connecticut, and an M. Phil and a Ph.D. in English Education from Teachers College, Columbia University. Dr. Budd has served as a content-area expert on assessment panels formed by CSDE (Connecticut State Department of Education), SBAC (Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium), NCSC (National Center and State Collaborative), and, most recently, the Thomas B. Fordham Institute. His professional publications include “Local Educators Look at the Common Core” (with Bernard Josefsberg, in *The Superintendent’s Fieldbook*, 2nd ed., Corwin, 2013); “The Common Core Standards: Using the Power Wisely” (*English Leadership Quarterly*, Oct. 2011); and “Romp with Joy and, Yes, Loving Poetry” (*English Leadership Quarterly*, April 2010). He is an active member of the Tri-State Consortium of high-performing school districts and regularly leads visit teams to other member districts. He was named Distinguished Alumnus of the University of Connecticut Administrative Preparation Program in 2019. Dr. Budd served as Director of Curriculum, Instruction, & Assessments from 2015-2017 and was appointed Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum, Instruction, & Assessments on July 1, 2017, and Assistant Superintendent on July 1, 2019.
