These waivers will ensure students and children *18 year old and under* **can continue to safely receive Free school meals through the 2021-22 School Year.**

Please note:

A La Carte items, are **not** included in the free waivers i.e. a sandwich, a salad, chips, cookies, ice cream, beverages. These choices are charged accordingly. Why Meal Application are Essential:

Applications for Free and Reduced Breakfast and Lunch for **2021-2022 School Year**. It is very important to complete an Application for Free & Reduced Meals for this upcoming school year. We also want to let you know that school meal applications are good for more than just free meals.

Benefits for your student and family

Free and Reduced Lunch application can be used to determine eligibility for: Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) benefits to help purchase food and discounted school fees.

Benefits for your school

Schools receive important funding and resources based on the number of free and reduced applications. Even as our district continues to provide *free meals to all students*, we still ask families to submit school meals applications. If you completed one prior to June 30, 2021 you will need to complete a new one for the **2021-22 school year**. Only one application is needed per family; if you have more than one child attending a school in our district, you only need to submit one application for all children.

There are no immigration requirements to participate in the Free & Reduced Meal program.
